Whereas last year we were facing huge increases in energy bills, this year starts with a drop in those prices, so outgoings for energy should be the same as last year. Overall 2023/24 returned a healthy surplus, so it is proposed that fees do not increase for the coming year.

Membership

Joining fee for new members (per application/family) remain same at £50

Standard annual family subscription £ 115 as last year (there is a pro rata rate if new members join part way through the year)

This is a standard rate for couples and families. This includes any children up to their 18th birthday (after that they need Young Persons membership)

There is now a different rate for single members, this is rate for single members £98 as last year

Senior family membership (incl any children under 18) same at £94 (both members need to be over 65 on 1st April 2023 and have been members for 3 years

Senior single membership same at £ 74) (member needs to be over 65 on 1st April 2023 and been a member for 3 years

Young Persons same at £25 For those over 18 but not yet 26 on 1st April 2023

There is a pro rata rate if new members join part way through the year.

The membership year runs from 1st April to 31st March.

Summer moorings 2024

Mooring fees are charged on banding basis. The length of your boat is the length a box would need to be if placed over the whole boat - including bowsprit and/or pulpit.
